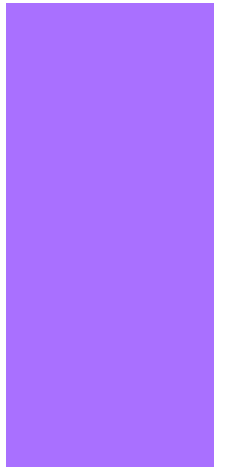


# Twitch Mini Chat visual guide

Twitch chat + Pokémon Community Game  
(PCG)

A manual mobile companion



# Your first PCG session takes three deliberate steps

## 01 ADD ACCOUNT

Choose a channel  
Enter a Twitch channel, complete Twitch Login, then tap the saved account to enter chat.

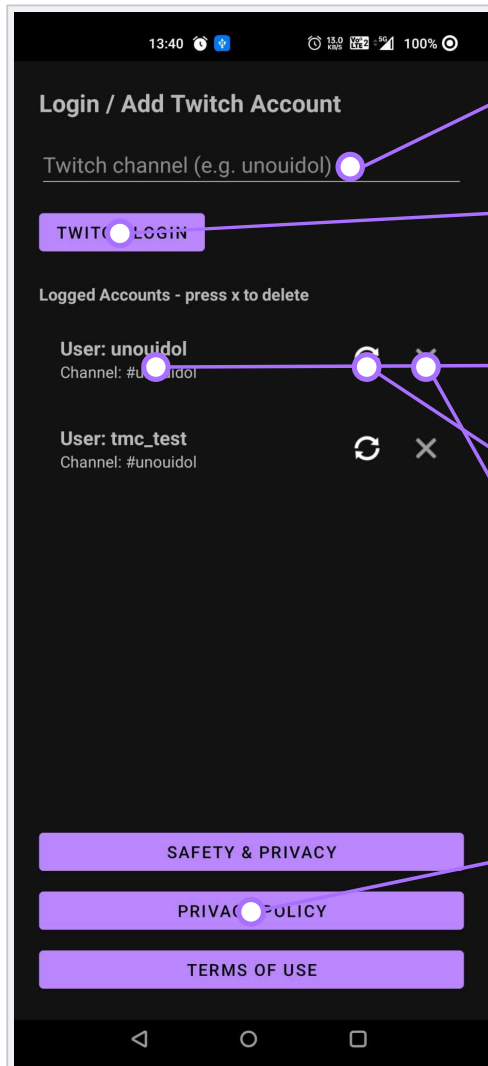
## 02 OPEN PCG

Authenticate PCG  
Tap Start PCG. The extension may ask for a separate Twitch sign-in.

## 03 UPDATE & PLAY

Update TMC tool  
Update Inventory and Pokédex on their correct tabs, set alerts, then choose every command yourself.

# Add accounts once, then reopen them with a tap



## 1 Channel for the new account

Enter the Twitch channel this account should open after login.

## 2 Twitch Login

Starts Twitch authorization for chat access and adds the account to TMC.

## 3 Saved account row

Tap to enter chat. Long-press and drag a row to reorder saved accounts.

## 4 Refresh authorization

Reauthorize the same Twitch identity if its session or emote access needs renewal.

## 5 Remove account

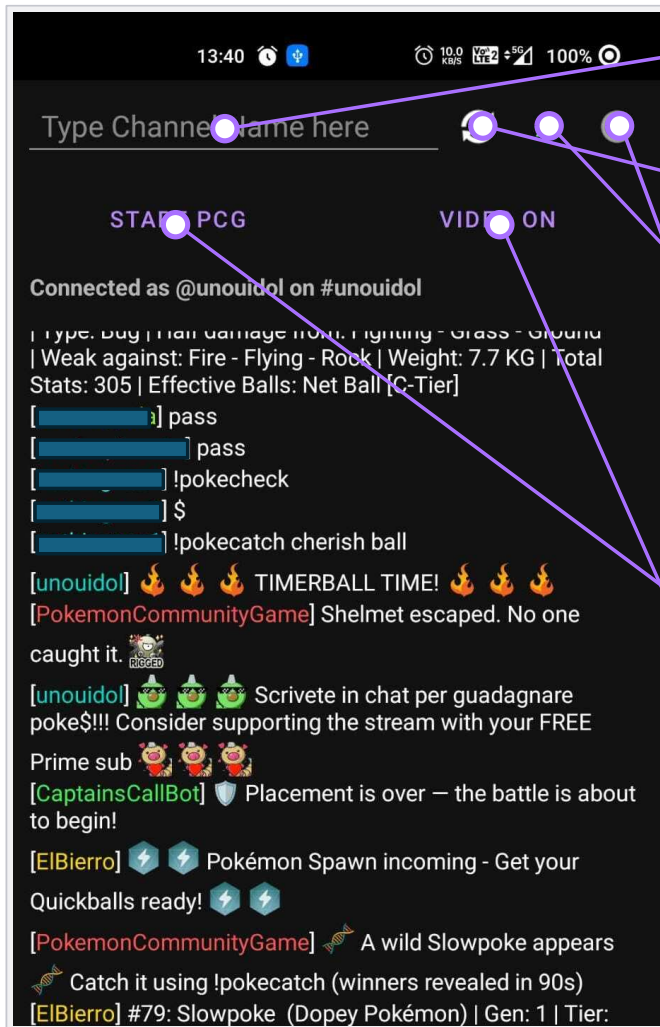
Deletes the selected account from this device after a confirmation step.

## 6 Policies and data controls

Open Safety & Privacy, the Privacy Policy, or the Terms of Use at any time.

Accounts can be re-ordered just by dragging them up or down

# The chat header controls channel, PCG, video, and alerts



## 1 Channel switcher

Type another channel or choose a recent one without changing the logged account.

## 2 Refresh chat

Runs a manual chat refresh when you want to reconnect or reload the current view.

## 3 PCG notifications

Opens per-profile spawn modes, event alerts, Most Wanted, sound, and vibration.

## 4 Safety & Privacy

Opens reporting, blocked users, policies, external-link choices, and data controls.

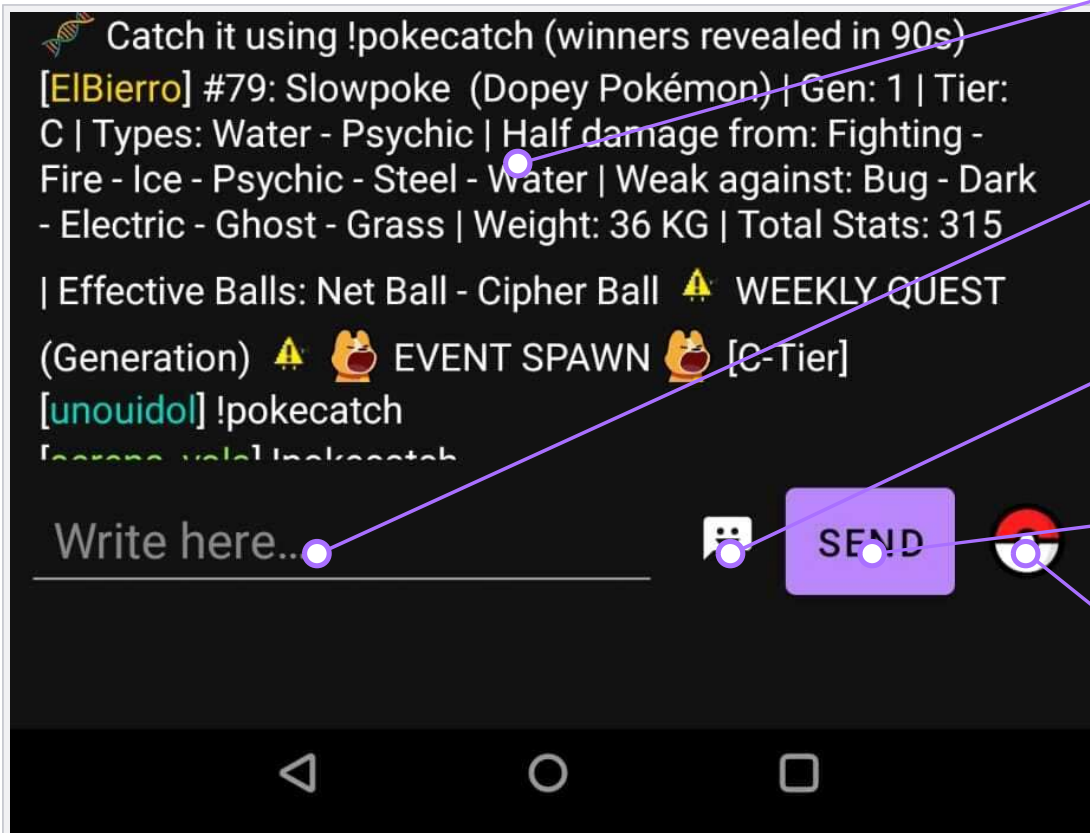
## 5 Start PCG

Opens the Pokémon Community Game extension for the current account.

## 6 Video On / Off

Shows or hides the Twitch stream player while keeping chat available. Once opened, the stream player can be muted on demand.

# Messages, emotes, and catch shortcuts stay under your control



## 1 Chat timeline & links

Supported web links shown in this area can be opened with your chosen external browser.

## 2 Message composer

Type a message or command here. Mention suggestions (@username) appear while you type.

## 3 Emote picker

Tap the speech-bubble face icon. Choosing an emote inserts text only; it does not send the emotes, you have to send the message with the button SEND

## 4 Send

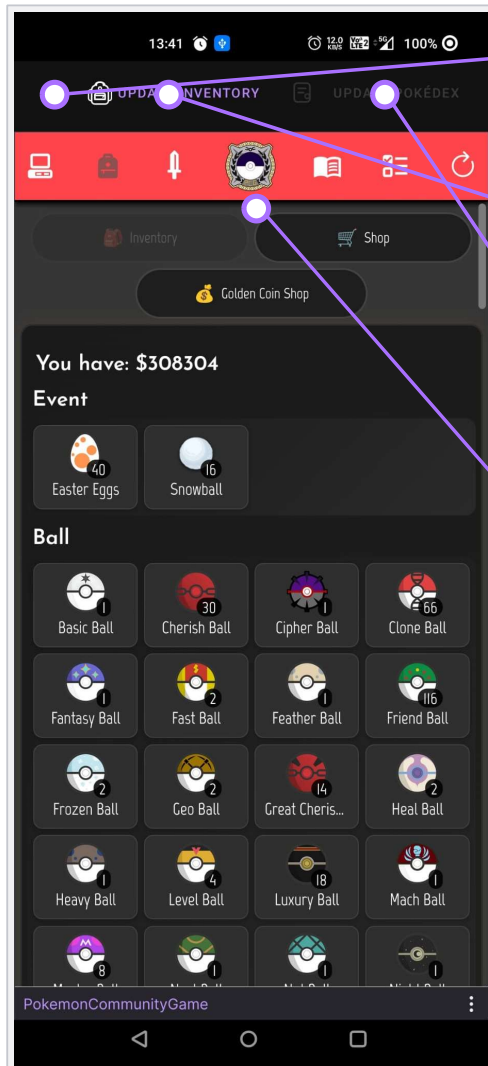
Sends the current composer text as one user-triggered Twitch chat action.

## 5 Catch Presets

Tap for quick presets. Long-press the Poké Ball to edit the full preset list.

Manual by design: one deliberate tap produces at most one visible chat or gameplay action.

# Open the correct PCG tab before updating local context



## 1 Refresh PCG

Reloads the extension surface manually if the embedded page is not ready.

## 2 Update Inventory

Open PCG Inventory first, then tap to record Poké Ball counts for the active profile (the inventory recording works only for English language at the moment). To change the PCG extension language, check point n. 4.

## 3 Update Pokédex

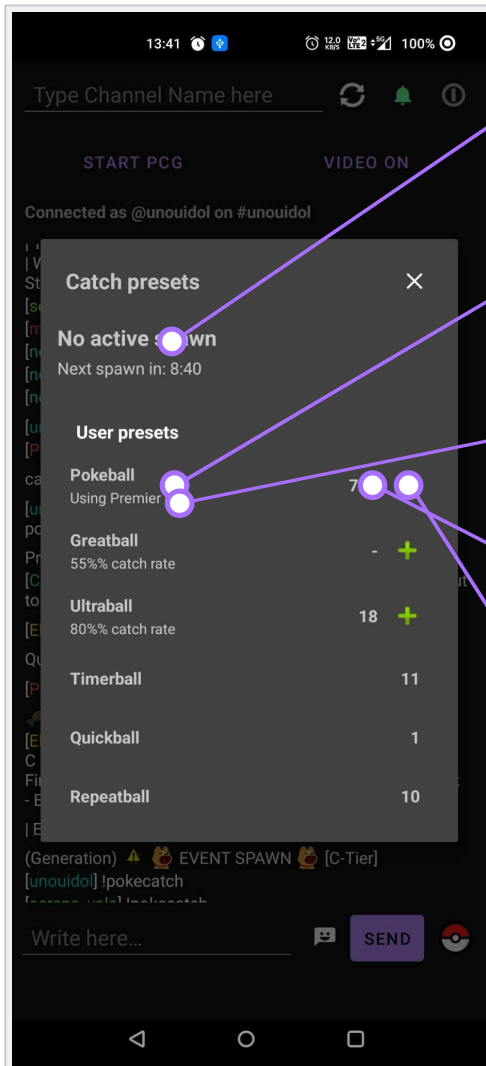
Open Pokédex with Spawnable only selected filter selected, then tap to record missing entries.

## 4 PCG navigation

Use the extension tabs normally. Only the update button matching the confirmed tab is enabled. Tap the PCG Logo to open the language selection menu.

Updates are passive snapshots initiated by your tap; TMC does not control the PCG page for you.

# Smart Catch explains choices, but every command remains manual



## 1 Spawn context

Shows the active spawn or the estimated time until the next normal spawn.

## 2 Tap a preset row

Sends that saved command once and closes the dialog. Nothing is queued or retried automatically.

## 3 Reason or catch rate

Subtitles explain the current recommendation or the preset's expected role.

## 4 Available quantity

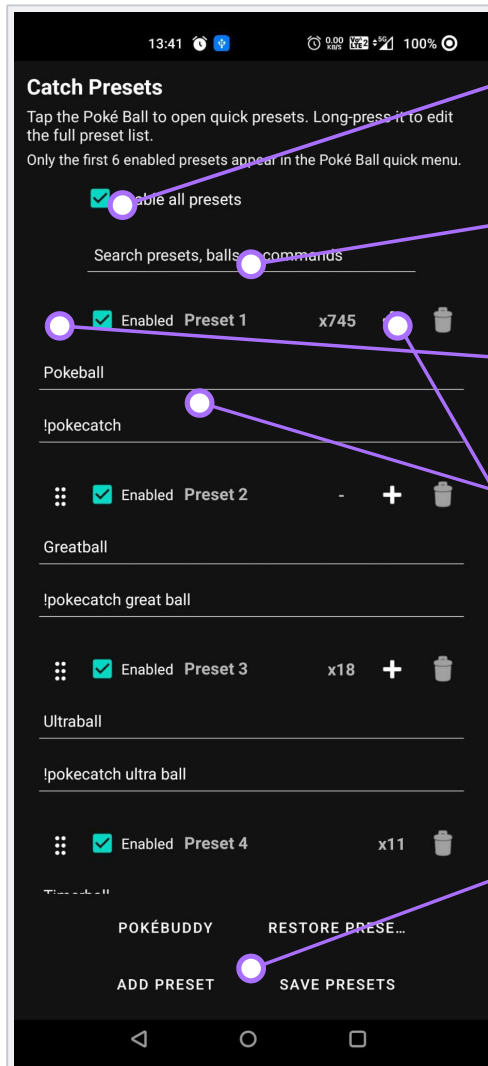
Counts come from the last inventory snapshot saved for this profile.

## 5 Buy shortcut

For supported balls, the green plus opens a quantity dialog for a manual purchase command.

When a spawn is active, Smart Presets can appear above User Presets based on spawn and inventory context.

# Long-press the Poké Ball to customize Catch Presets



## 1 Enable presets

Use Enable all or the per-row checkbox to control which shortcuts can appear.

## 2 Search

Filter by preset label, ball, or command without deleting hidden rows.

## 3 Reorder

Drag the dotted handle. Only the first six enabled presets appear in the quick menu.

## 4 Edit label and command

Give each shortcut a clear name and the exact command it should send when tapped.

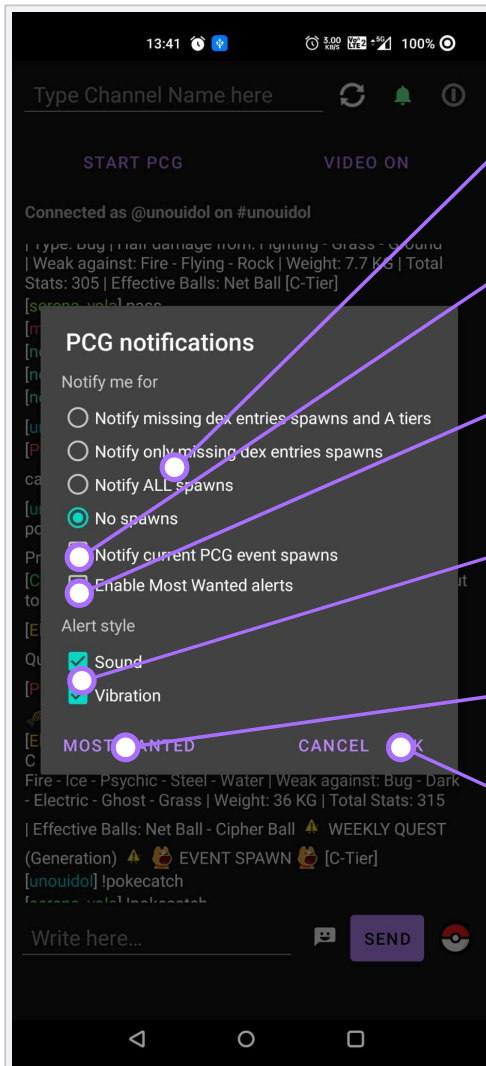
## 5 Count, buy, or remove

Review inventory, use + for supported purchases, or remove an unwanted preset.

## 6 Utility and save actions

Request Pokébuddy info (and stores them for friend ball suggestions), restore defaults, add a preset, or save the edited list.

# Choose exactly which PCG notifications each profile receives



## 1 Base spawn mode

Choose missing Dex + A tiers, missing Dex only, all spawns, or no standard spawns.

## 2 Current event spawns

Adds event-spawn alerts independently from the selected base mode.

## 3 Most Wanted alerts

Enables matches from the separate watchlist saved for this profile.

## 4 Alert style

Choose whether matching notifications use sound, vibration, both, or neither.

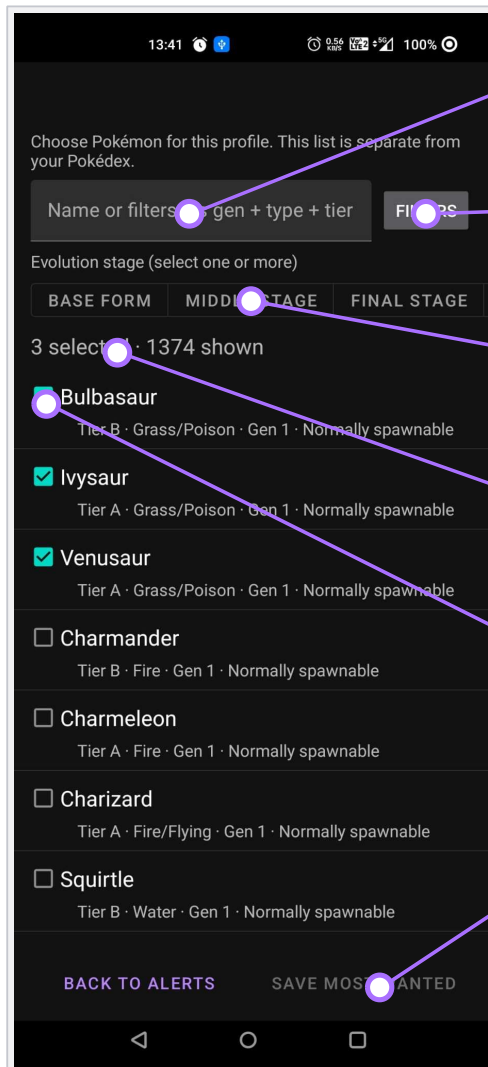
## 5 Open Most Wanted

Leaves this dialog and opens the searchable Pokémon watchlist editor.

## 6 Save settings

Tap OK to apply the selected notification mode and delivery style.

# Most Wanted is separate from your Pokédex



## 1 Search by name or shorthand

Type a Pokémon name or combine supported generation, type, and tier terms.

## 2 Advanced Filters

Refine tier, type, generation, variants, availability, or special categories. Filters can be combined with evolution stage selectors.

## 3 Evolution stages

Select one or more stages to combine them in the same catalog filter.

## 4 Selection count

Shows how many Pokémon are selected and how many match the current filters.

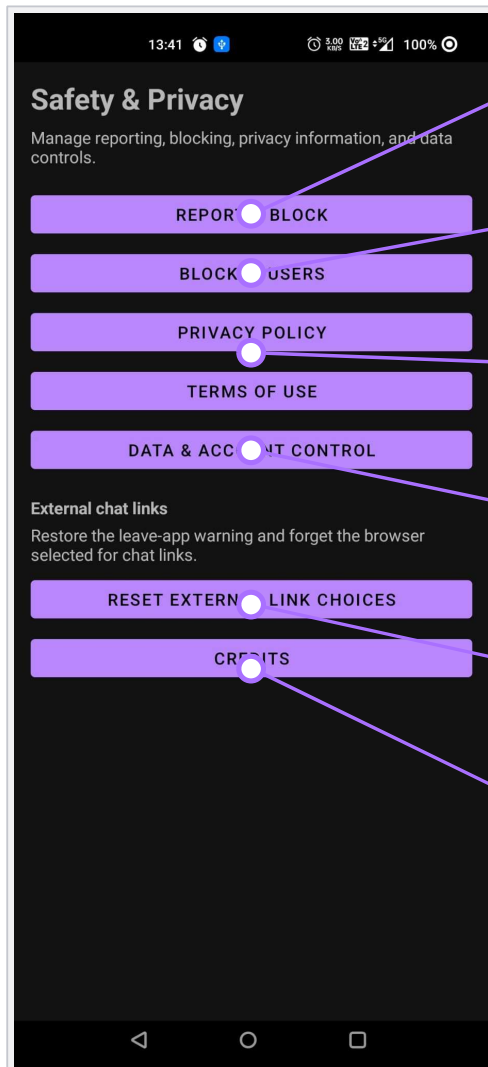
## 5 Build the watchlist

Check or uncheck Pokémon. The choices belong to the current PCG profile.

## 6 Save Most Wanted

Stores the list for this profile; Back to Alerts returns to notification settings.

# Safety, privacy, and data controls remain easy to reach



## 1 Report & Block

Open reporting tools and hide abusive or unwanted chat users locally.

## 2 Blocked Users

Review hidden users and restore them when you want to see their messages again.

## 3 Policies

Read the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use from inside the app.

## 4 Data & Account Control

Manage local resets and account/server-data deletion options.

## 5 External-link choices

Restore the leave-app warning and forget the browser selected for chat links.

## 6 Credits

Review third-party components, acknowledgements, and project information.
